



Setting up Your Classes

1. Log into the **Teacher Portal** at <https://portal.playmada.com> with your username and password.



2. You should see 1 class (**LastName Class 1**) in your class list. If you teach more than 1 class, you can add additional classes by selecting **+ADD CLASS** in the top right corner.



Setting up Your Classes (cont.)

3. Input your Class name. A Class description and Class code* are optional.

**If you input a class code, it must be at least 6 characters, include only alphanumeric characters, and should have no spaces. The Class code will be automatically generated if you do not include one.*



Inviting Your Students to Join a Class

1. In the **Teacher Portal** at (<https://portal.playmada.com>), select the class in which you'd like to invite students to join.
2. Once in the class, you can view your Class Code.
3. Students can join by one of the following options:

If you are ready for your students to play Collisions:


- 1) Direct your students to the Collisions game login page.
 - **Web:** <https://app.playmada.com/Collisions>
 - **iPad or Android Tablet:** Download **Collisions: Play Chemistry** in the App Store or Google Play



- 2) Students should click '**JOIN A CLASS**.'
- 3) Then, students should **enter the class code** and create an account.

4. After entering the class code, students will be asked to complete the following steps when setting up their account:

Requirements:

- First and Last names must have at least 2 characters.
- Please do not include any spaces in your answers.
- The **Username** must be at least 6 characters and can include letters and numbers.
- The **Password** must be at least 8 characters and can include the following: uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers and these special characters (!, @, #, \$, %, *).





1. Log into the **Teacher Portal** at <https://portal.playmada.com> with your username and password.
2. Select a class.

Manage Students



If you need to reset a student password or unblock an account:

1. Select **Manage Students**.
2. Click the **Student Name**.
3. Click the **ACTIONS** button (down arrow) in top right corner:
 - 1) **Reset student password**
 - This will reset your student password to the student username. When the student next logs into Collisions, the password will need to be reset.
 - 2) **Remove from class**
 - If this student is no longer enrolled in this class, you can remove the student. This will not delete the student gameplay progress. If this student joins another class, progress will be saved.


Logging Into Collisions
